Dear Friends,

Beginning the first week of February, we will be leasing the above stated parking lot to the Village of New Hyde Park from February 1, 2020 until January 31, 2021, with a possible three-month extension. Mayor Larry Montreuil requested a meeting with me last April to ask if this would be possible. Although I appreciate the support the Village has shared with our parish since I arrived almost seven years ago, I did not feel comfortable with this proposal. At least, not at first!

After ongoing conversations between the Village, myself and our Holy Spirit Finance Committee, and the consortium responsible for the LIRR project, 3TC, we agreed on a contract favorable to everyone. We can still use our parking lot on Sundays and other times which will be outlined in next week's bulletin. What you need to know at this time is that, although we may be somewhat inconvenienced at times, our parish will benefit and the people of our community will benefit from this agreement. Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

- 1) Isaiah 8:23-9:3
- 2) 1 Corinthians 1:10-13, 17
- 3) Matthew 4:12-23 or 4:12-17

FOCUS: The life of a disciple calls for repentance and courage.

Jesus fulfills all prophecy and brings light to our darkness. He calls his disciples out of their way of life – from fishermen to fishers of men. He calls us to follow him, too, so as to bring light, truth and goodness into a world that needs repentance.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Isaiah writes of the day when all gloom is gone. Light will come to the people who walked in darkness, and they will rejoice. Saint Paul urges the Corinthians to have no divisions among [them]. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, calls Simon, Andrew, James and John to follow him. The brothers leave everything and follow Jesus.
