To Our Holy Spirit Family,

Hello my name is Henry Padilla and would like to take this opportunity to say "Thank You" to all for your prayers and well wishes. As you may (or may not) know I have recently undergone a heart transplant on May 23rd. I was touched when my son Kevin told me of the many parishioners who approached him at Church and at the Festival with their love and prayers. I always knew I was surrounded by the Love of God, Family and Friends.

Last year on March 23rd, I had surgery to implant a heart pump to assist my failing heart. I received many prayers and well wishes during that time. On Good Friday last year, the day we know God's love for us, I felt the strongest since my surgery and was moved out of ICU. I took this as a sign that I would be fine. This year on May 23rd, I received the call that a donor heart was available. I was in the hospital for 12 days, but the day I remember most is May 30th, Ascension Thursday, when on the electronic board in my room, my discharge date was posted.

I feel that I am blessed to have had two major surgeries during Holy Days, where we see God's love. Along with all the outpouring of well wishes and support of Father Grieco, I am grateful to be part of such a caring Parish Family.

My wife Diana, my sons Kevin and Jason, and I would like to "Thank All" for your support during these difficult times.

Are pro-lifers racist?

In a recent interview with the Des Moines Register Senator Kirsten Gillibrand, who has announced her candidacy for U. S. President, equated being pro-life with being racist. She is quoted as having said, "Opposition to abortion rights is the moral equivalent of racism."

Roland C. Warren, the president and CEO of CareNet, an association of crisis pregnancy centers, such as LI Life Center and Soundview Pregnancy Services, who is himself African American, answered her charge with a counter-charge, implying that it is abortion which is accomplishing the goals of racists. Mr. Warren defined racists as those who seek to dehumanize other people based solely on the color of their skin. Racists deny such people their rights. In fact, racists would like to eradicate them. To substantiate his claim, Mr. Warren quoted statistics from the Center for Disease Control (CDC) which indicate that 50% of all African American pregnancies end in abortion. (HALF of all preborn African American babies die of "choice"). Since the Roe v. Wade decision in 1973, 19 million African American babies have been aborted; that is 35% of all abortions have been performed on a group that constitutes only 12% of the entire United States population.

Let's set the record straight. Pro-life people see ALL human life as sacred, no matter a person's skin color, country of origin, religion, etc. Pro-life people seek to protect life in all its DIVERSITY. They want to ensure the rights of liberty for all-the first such right being the RIGHT TO LIFE. Pro-life people, racists? Nothing could be further from the truth.

## Gospel Meditation

### June 30, 2019: 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Have you ever heard that the Gospel is radical? In our times, we hear that word and think of fundamentalists, radical activists, or extremists - people who go beyond limits to achieve their goals and may not consider themselves bound by normal propriety or morality. Their ethos might not be so different from James and John in today's Gospel. "Lord, do you want us to call down fire from heaven to consume them?" This isn't so foreign to some of the stories of the Old Testament. Yet Jesus rebukes them. He won't be exacting in the way his contemporaries expected. There will be no radical rain down of fire and brimstone. Jesus is radical in another way: the call to discipleship.

"The Son of Man has nowhere to rest his head." "Let the dead bury their dead. But you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God." "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks back to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." These can be difficult passages to read. These are not normal things to hear! It can be easy for many of us to avoid the exacting nature of the Gospel, which might not be what we think it is. James and John wanted to set the bar high for others on the outside and to punish those who didn't meet that standard. Jesus sets the bar high for his disciples, those who say they want to follow him. He may be using some hyperbole, but it's only to send a clear message. This is a radical call, one that has a cost. To truly put God and others first, before ourselves, will involve sacrifice. How is Jesus asking you to be radical today?

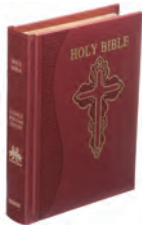
