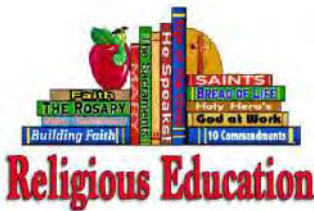

Members in uniform should meet between 10:45 and 11:15 a.m., at the Firehouse located at 11 S. 5th Street in New Hyde Park.

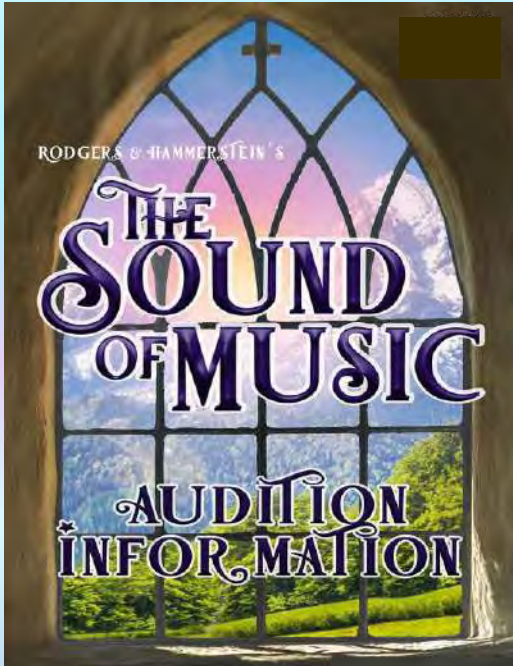


After the 11:30 a.m. Mass, all parishioners are welcome to attend a brief service at the Firehouse, located at 1555 Jericho Turnpike, NHP.

Reflection

Sunday, August 22, 2021

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

(Lec. 122)

- 1) Joshua 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b
- 2) Ephesians 5:21-32 or 5:2a, 25-32
- 3) John 6:60-69

FOCUS: The immense love God has for his people prompts us to love in return.

The theme for today's readings is fidelity between God and his people. How loyal are we to Jesus? Are we able to take Peter's words as our own? *Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.* How well do we even know the words of Jesus? Let us recommit ourselves to deepening our knowledge and love of the Lord.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Joshua and the tribes of Israel state their fidelity to the Lord God. In his Letter to the Ephesians, Saint Paul draws a parallel between a spousal relationship and the radical love between Christ and the Church. In the Gospel, Jesus proclaims that his words are Spirit and life, after which only some of his followers continued as disciples.
