Faith in Action

It is no coincidence that October is both Respect Life month and the month dedicated to the Holy Rosary. If there was ever a time in our history that the powerful weapon of the Rosary is needed to combat the forces of evil, intent on cheapening and destroying life, it is now.

To prove my point about destroying life, here are a few headlines:

- Pelosi Arrests Pro-Lifers Protesting Her Plan to Fund Abortions
- Candidate Claims it's a 'Real Disadvantage' Women Can't Get Full Term Abortions
- New York's Governor Wants Facebook to 'curb' the Spread of the Pro-life Message
- MSNBC Guest Compares Pro-Lifers to Suicide Bombers
- Actress Claims Saving Babies from Abortion is 'Racist'

Really? **People who want to save babies from death are racists and terrorists, who should be silenced or jailed?** Who or what is behind this full-fledged attack on life? St. Paul in his letter to the Ephesians tells us, "For we are not contending against flesh and blood... but against the spiritual host of wickedness" (Eph. 6:12).

Let us fight back. Let us use, not worldly weapons, but a more powerful and effective one for combating evil, the Rosary. Let us invoke the Blessed Mother by saying the Rosary daily to help us in our struggle. Or sit down at your laptop and email your Congressperson to support the inclusion of the Hyde Amendment in budget bills so that we do not have our tax dollars paying for abortion.

Also from your laptop, email your Congressperson to support H.R. 5163, "Care for Her", a bill which will facilitate support and services to women who find themselves with an unexpected pregnancy, to meet the emotional, physical, social, financial, and other needs that a woman encounters during pregnancy, childbirth, and childrearing.

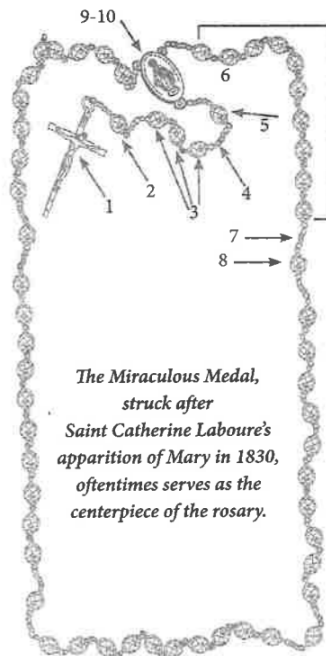

How to Pray the Rosary

1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the "Apostles Creed."
 2. Say the "Our Father."
 3. Say three "Hail Marys."
 4. Say the "Glory be to the Father."
 5. Announce the first mystery; then say the "Our Father."
 6. Say ten "Hail Marys," while meditating on the mystery.
 7. Say the "Glory be to the Father" and the "Fatima Prayer."
 8. Announce the second mystery; then say the "Our Father."
- Repeat 6 and 7, and continue with third, fourth, and fifth mysteries in the same manner.
9. Say the "Hail Holy Queen."
 10. Say the "Prayer after the Rosary."
